
This annual event is designed to foster a love for reading among young readers and provide them with an opportunity to explore new stories and adventures.

- Reading Log: Children will receive a reading log/ activity booklet to track the books they read. They can also write reviews and share their thoughts on the stories.




Attend Events: Participate in the various events and activities organized by the library to enhance the reading experience.

 A charming tale about a bird-themed party.


