The building opened in March 1999, and is also known as the Thomas Coogan Library. It was originally the Presentation Convent Secondary School.

My Open Library service at Castlecomer Library offers extended opening hours to library members on a self-service basis outside normal opening hours, from 8am to 10pm, seven days a week. Library members must be 16 years or over, and register beforehand with staff. (T&C's apply). There are no staff present when My Open Library service is in operation, and the building is monitored with CCTV cameras. Members can access Wi-Fi and avail of self-service printing and photocopying, borrowing and returning items and using the
